

- I. Opening
 - A. LEC opened at 10:35AM, presided by David Clegg
 - B. Attendance (page 3)
- II. Reports
 - A. EVC - We did great service this weekend, thanks to all who helped put it together
 - B. PVC - It was a very successful weekend with good service. Thanks to the unsung heroes who made it happen.
 - C. SVC - With about 200 attendants we accomplished about 1400 man-hours to the camp. Thank you to the Chapter Chiefs for bringing your arrowmen out, but we want even more at our future events.
 - D. Negwegon - Focusing on Elections and Arrowman retention/brotherhood conversion
 - E. Nising Ojibway - 1 Election and 1 Crossover since last LEC. We have an election scheduled for tonight (17th) and 2 crossovers and an event scheduled. The event will include a call out of those elected. Day of service scheduled for June 17th
 - F. Washetauni - We presented at Round Table and have done 1 call out since the last LEC. Elections are ongoing and we have scheduled another MTG tournament for May 30th, as well as an event with Topi-Kittan on June 11th.
 - G. Trading Post - We made \$3600 this weekend, about half of that being NOAC and JDRF sales. We are at approximately 22% of our \$10,000 goal for JDRF, and donations are now available online. There will be a Chapter Insignia meeting at the Big Event. We now have a total of 97 patch subscriptions.
- III. Old Business
 - A. Dues - All Chapter officers should be encouraging their members to pay dues
 - B. Conclave - We had 90 people attend, and our ceremonies team was recognized as the best in the section for the second year in a row. We received the Section Participation award and the theme for next year's Conclave is Section Strikes Back.
 - C. Elections - Chapters should aim for June 1st to be done with elections, but they will be occurring at summer camps until August 1st. Chapter Chiefs should direct any Arrowmen at Rota-Kiwan and Cole Canoe Base to Joel Holland or David Clegg to discuss elections at those camps.
 - D. Big Event - We are expecting 100+ attendees, there will be a Chapter competition for the Chapter Cup as well as prizes for Chapter, Troops, and Individuals that participate in activities. Friday night will feature a MTG tournament run by Zach Richardson, and Saturday will feature a Decathlon-like event of activities for points in the competitions. There will be a brotherhood ceremony as well as the Vigil Induction this weekend as well. Saturday night will have a luau dinner and a Best Worst Hawaiian Shirt contest.

 - C. OA CSP for Camperships - The Council would like to create a Centennial OA CSP, the proceeds of which to go directly to funding Camperships. The patch was designed in the

last month and the council would like Lodge approval of the design. They will be sold for \$20 and will be included in our patch subscription for no additional cost. The exact number to be ordered are still to be determined, as is whether it will be a uniform acceptable patch. Zack Smith motioned to approve the design, Zach Richardson seconded. The vote was unanimous in approval with 8 votes cast (Joel Holland casting his in advance via Kirk Sheren his advisor, having already been briefed). After examining the two designs, the committee selected the Krelman design citing that it was a cleaner design and more closely resembled our NOAC patches.

- D. Little Forks Conservancy in Midland would like to install a staircase this summer and is asking us to set it up as a service project. The materials are at the site and have been paid for, we would merely be providing the labor. They are looking for 20-30 people over the course of 3 days yet to be determined. They will also be planting some trees. Zack Smith will be getting more information about a date and reporting at the Big Event.
