IT'LL BE A GREAT TIME AT NOAC 2018!

The next NATIONAL ORDER OF THE ARROW CONFERENCE (NOAC) is hosted by Indiana University in Bloomington. This national event is in our own Central Region and close – less than 5 hours away from Lansing.

The conference begins on Monday July 30th and runs through Saturday August 4th. Our lodge will leave on Sunday, July 29th from the Flint / Lansing area. The cost for a lodge member is \$600.00 – a reduction of \$100 because of lodge financial support!



The week-long conference fee includes: Housing and Meals, Athletic Competitions, Conference Trainings, Programs and Shows, Native American Adventures, and Lodge Activities.

BE an IRON ARROWMAN in 2018




